Onil had always found it unbelievable that a person a thousand miles away and from all the way across the other side of the world actually cares—for him and the Chakma community. He is grateful that a poor farm boy from a remote mountain village in India has found Mom Dana and the wonderful people from Seeds of Love Worldwide.

Onil Bikash Chakma is 17 years old and grew up knowing nothing more but the back breaking life of tilling a hard and rocky soil. He readily admits that he

came from a poor and uneducated family. His father is a farmer but with the little amount of money he gets from the harvest, he would immediately spend it on alcohol instead of providing food on the table and education for his children. But Onil's mother who suffers from cancer tries her best to earn some money, so her children would be able to get proper education. He comes from a far flung and undeveloped mountain village with non-existent basic government services. A place where there are no hospitals, no schools— hence, most of the people in the village are uneducated. But his mother wants to break that chain and have her children live a better life through education. Because of this dream, Onil had to leave his ailing mother so he can go to school at Mahabodhi Residential School (MBRS) in Tuichawng.

His simple dream in life is to learn; achieve higher education and get a college degree. After that, Onil plans to go back to his village to help improve the lives of the Chakma community. He is currently in Grade 10 and intensely focused to work and study hard in order to achieve this dream. His unwavering determination reflects on his grades as he is always at the top of his class. Onil also wants his mother's hard work even in her weak physical state to matter. Earlier this year, his family can no longer afford to pay for school fees and he had no other recourse but to quit school. He was devastated and didn't know what to do. Sir Sadak, the Principal of MBRS and the school

committee who knows Onil's full potential, allowed him to stay for free in the hostel as they tried to find ways to help. This is the part where your support to Seeds of Love becomes a catalyst for change. Onil knows that he is fortunate that SOLWW has offered him a scholarship so he can focus and continue his studies. He values this opportunity and promises to do his best to excel in class.

As a recipient of Seeds of Love Worldwide scholarship, Onil is currently working on the Community Service Volunteer requirement by tutoring five class 10 students in Math and Social Studies. This role has added another goal on his list; to help these five students pass the Term 2 exams in December. Knowing that his destiny is within reach, Onil will never forget your help and generosity through SOLWW for the rest of his life, and will always be grateful.
